I. For Youth Parents:

To build up the self esteem of our children To lay a quality foundation for their life

Situation:

As parents, have you found your teenage children not having motivation to do things? Always holding on to their mobile phones? Lack of confidence after entering high school? Getting more and more tensed while doing things, unable to let go?

Teenage behavior problems have very much to do with mental health. Their emotional appeal also links to how they perceive themselves, others, future and life....

Objective:

This series will help parents build up the self-esteem of their teenage children, not only reducing their behavioral problems, but also helping them face their lives, relationships and learn different aspects of challenges with a strong spirit and good attitude.

Target:

Primarily Chinese parents with teenage children, also welcome youth workers.

Language: Cantonese (with English materials).

Course Features:

- Equal emphasis on theory, cases and practicality. Local brothers and sisters will be invited to lead small group discussions, feedbacks within local context.
- Learning methods: every session will have 45 minutes of lecture or video; and 30 minutes of group discussion; a total of 4 sessions (5 hours)

II. For Youth Workers:

Nurturing the internet generation Fulfilling the mission of heavenly people

Situation:

The social and cultural situations of the youth today are very volatile. There are many controversies among political, economic, social, family and educational issues. Our internet generation are growing up in an information explosion age, so they can explore and participate in all kinds of social concerns in an unprecedented manner. At the same time, they would continue to face the responsibilities and challenges of growing up with a sensitive and gentle heart.

In present days, the youth workers must ask: how do we help the youth discern the truth in this world with chaotic value system and no clear distinction between right and wrong? How does faith become the core value of the lives of our youth? And how can faith shine on their path ahead and let the youth reflect upon themselves, aware of the presence of God and walk in the light? How should the youth workers walk, share and experience life together with the youth, and help them fulfill the mission of heavenly people?

Objective:

To help youth workers know the culture and characteristics of internet generation, understand the influence of social culture on youth, and help the youth live out their faith in their daily lives. Also to understand deeper the basic characters of youth workers so that they can walk with the youth in a closer manner.

Target:

Chinese Youth Pastors, Youth Leaders, Parents

Language:

Cantonese (with English materials).

Course Features:

- Equal emphasis on theory, actual cases and practicality. Local brothers and sisters will be invited to lead small group discussions, feedbacks within local context.
