Our Family Internet Ground Rules

The following Ground Rules establishes the way we will use computers in our home. We will display this game plan and update it periodically as our children grow older.

- 1. We will never give out personal information such as our last name, address or phone number. We should also not give out the name of our school, our city, our siblings, our sports team or our parent's workplace.
- 2. We all agree to not give our passwords to anyone outside of our family. We have all agreed upon user names to use while we are on the Internet. I will not change the settings for my computer or my password without my parent's permission.
- 3. We all agree to limit our online time so that it doesn't interfere with other activities. We agree to follow the time limits that our family sets and not let the Internet take time away from homework, sports, face- to-face interactions or family time.
- 4. **I will never meet an online friend in person**. Just as I stay away from strangers on the street, I will be careful about strangers on the Internet. If anyone ever asks to meet with me off line, I will notify my parents immediately.
- 5. I will tell my mom or dad right away if I come across something that makes me feel uncomfortable. If anyone uses bad language or mentions things that make me uncomfortable, I will immediately log off and tell my parents.
- 6. **I will not remain on or click on a page that says, "For Over 18 Years Only."** If this happens, I will log off and I will let my parents know. I understand that I'm only a click away from bad sites and that these pages are definitely not for kids.
- 7. I will only download pictures and files with my parent's permission. Some of these files may contain inappropriate pictures or dangerous viruses that could mess up our computer.
- 8. **I will not send pictures of my family or myself to anyone online**. The only way that I am allowed to do this is if my parents say it is all right.
- 9. **I will be safe everywhere**. I will follow the same Internet safety rules at my friends' houses, at school and at the library that I do while I'm at home.
- 10. **I understand that nothing is private on the Internet**. I agree that my mom or dad can read my mail or check the sites that I have been visiting not because they don't trust me but because they just want to make sure that I am safe.

<u>www.getnetwise.org</u> is a public service organization that gives you tips and information about the problem use of the internet for kids, and make complaints to internet providers and websites.

<u>www.cvnt.net</u> **Covenant Eyes** includes a filter to block sites but is most valuable as it maintains a complete "Accountability Log" of all sites which are visited on your computer and issues weekly or monthly reports to 1-3 accountability partners you have designated. Since others will see every site you visit and how long you were there, these reports form the basis of discussion/accountability of appropriate use of the internet. Drawback: No I-Phone version available and only works up to Windows Mobile 6. ******RECOMMENDED**

<u>www.InternetSafety.com</u> is the website for **Safe Eyes**, one of the two leading filter and accountability programs. Drawback: only one accountability partner/administrator. One current advantage is Safe Eyes works on I-Phones, and Windows Mobile 7. ****RECOMMENDED

<u>www.Bsecure.com</u> is the website for **Bsecure**, another web filter and accountability program. It can set up it's accountability reports to include gambling related sites. BSecure also has a free filter app for I-Phones. ******RECOMMENDED**

The site also sells a DVD on porn recovery which is of average quality, the therapist behind this site is apparently LDS—but this is not prominent in the material.

<u>www.xxxChurch.com</u> The leading site for pornography recovery with lots of great resources. One outstanding resource is **3XPure**, an **online 30 day workshop** (workbook based, with online videos, readings). ******RECOMMENDED**

<u>www.sexaddicts.com</u> Doug Weiss is a leading Christian therapist working with men and couples affected by sexual addictions. Doug has spoken at Smarter Families Canada and his materials are used at Northview MB in their support groups. Weiss has lots of video lectures, books available, as well as 3 day couple intensives in Colorado at the Heart to Heart counselling centre. ****RECOMMENDED

Tools for Empowerment in Setting Healthy Boundaries for Internet Connectivity

Introduction:

- 1. Filters can be set to control use, content or specific websites. Particularly important for children.
- 2. Entertainment devices typically already have parental controls built in—use them.
- 3. Accountability programs send reports of website visits and searches to an accountability partner. This makes users visible and accountable to others for their choices. HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.
- 4. Filter programs are available for PCs, but NOT for Apple products or Android.
- 5. Accountability programs are available for all devices, except Blackberry.

Software Programs (install on each computer or device)

- **Covenant Eyes** is excellent for its filtering and accountability software. As of March 2011 it offers both filtering and accountability for all PCs; no filtering but accountability programming for Apple products (Macs, iPhones, iTouch and iPads). Blackberry and Android not covered. <u>www.covenanteyes.com</u>
- **X3watchPro** from XXXChurch is filtering and accountability software for PC, Mac, iPhone, iPad and Android based devices. <u>http://x3watch.com/x3watchpro.html</u>
- **Mobile Nanny** is a cell-phone and related device program to monitor activity on cellular devices, including the BlackBerry. <u>http://www.mobile-nanny.com/features.html</u>
- **Safe Eyes** is a leading filtering and monitoring software program for PCs, Macs and iPhones. <u>www.internetsafety.com</u>
